Agenda: Items include Call to Order; Senate Bill 702 budget note, executive director's report, updates on OHCC budget, HUBB, STEPS, Registry, Workers' Compensation; and Public Comment.

The Home Care Commission is responsible for ensuring the quality of publicly funded in-home care services. The commission has three major charges: (1) to define qualifications of homecare workers; (2) to create a statewide registry of homecare workers; and (3) to provide training opportunities for homecare workers. Beyond these responsibilities, the Home Care Commission is also the employer-of-record for purposes of collective bargaining for homecare workers whose pay comes from public funds.
